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The Somerset Building Awards are sponsored by Tauntfield Ltd (the Stansell Family Company) in memory of William Stansell (1910-1987). He was the Chairman of the Stansell Group of companies which was founded in 1823, in Taunton. His main love was the conservation and repair of historic buildings and he personally supervised the work carried out on many churches in the West Country, including Wells Cathedral, Sherborne Abbey and Bath Abbey. He had incredible expertise in restoration and conservation, built up from a lifetime's work on historic buildings.

The Somerset Building Preservation Trust was founded in 1988. Its main purpose is to help preserve the architectural heritage of Somerset for the benefit of the people of Somerset and of the nation as a whole. The Trust also exists to educate the public on the importance of preserving and enhancing the man-made environment.

The work must have been completed within the period 1st January 2010 – 31st December 2011, and be in the administrative area of either Somerset County Council, Sedgemoor District Council, Mendip District Council, West Somerset Council, Taunton Deane Borough Council, South Somerset District Council or North Somerset Council.

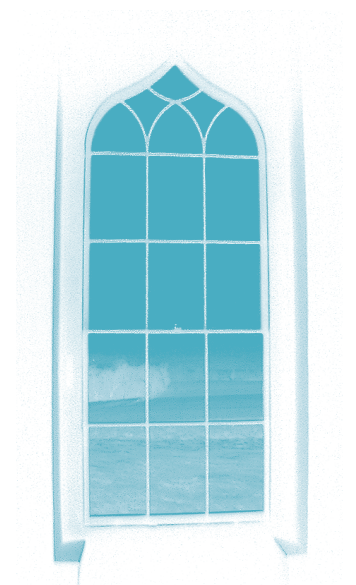
